The commitment is for a period of one year from July 2012 to July 2013.

The welfare of your child will always be our primary concern throughout the selection process. We ask that you communicate with your child that they are very special regardless if they are selected to be an Ambassador or not. A savings bond or scholarship will be awarded at the end of the Ambassador commitment.

Candidate Requirements:

- 1 - Must be old enough to enter Kindergarten, 1st or 2nd grade for the 2012-2013 school year.
- 2 - Candidate is a legal permanent resident.
- 3 - Never have represented a city or organization in the capacity of Junior Ambassador.
- 4 - Must submit a recent photo of self, copy of birth certificate, and completed application form.
- 5 - Since January 1, 2012 must:
 - a. Be attending a Robbinsdale District 281 School, **or**
 - b. Parents/Guardians live in or work in the Robbinsdale School District 281 area, **or**
 - c. Parent/Guardian is a volunteer for Whiz Bang for 1 year prior to application
- 6 - Must agree to participate in ALL scheduled events for the Junior Ambassador Candidate Program. A complete list of events will be given at the Orientation meeting.
- 7 - **Must have Parents/Guardians available to assist** with appearances throughout the year if selected as a Robbinsdale Whiz Bang Days Junior Ambassador.
- 8 - Must be available to attend all scheduled Whiz Bang activities through July 2013, if selected as an Ambassador.
